

Tax Home Declaration

I have completed the Tax Home Declaration Worksheet and consulted with an independent tax advisor, and now make the following good faith declaration.

Please check statement #1, #2, #3 or #4. The address section must be completed if statement #1, 2, or 3 is selected.

1.	I have and maintain a permanent tax home, and I would like to take advantage of the ax-free meal per diem, housing, and mileage benefits. I am aware that these tax-free trave enefits are not guaranteed because I have a permanent tax home and that othe equirements must be met.
2.] I have a permanent tax home, but I am declining to accept the tax-free meal per diem ousing and mileage benefits;
3.	I do not qualify because my permanent tax home is within commuting distance and/only assignment will exceed the one year limit and will no longer be considered temporary for purposes.
	The address provided must be a physical address and must be consistent with the W-4 form that is on file with American Traveler and affiliates. A PO Box will not be accepted.
4.	I do not maintain a permanent tax home. I understand the IRS considers my tax home the emporary lodging I receive while on assignment. (I understand that without a permanent tax home, all lodging costs and/or allowances, mileage reimbursements, other ansportation costs, and meal and incidental per diem benefits provided to me will be eated as taxable wages. I further understand that the only state income tax withheld from any paycheck will be that of the assignment state.)
